RIDERS BRIEFINGS

Riders Briefing will be held each morning at 7:20am on Friday and 7:00am Saturday and Sunday.

All riders participating in each days practice, qualifying, and or races are required to attend.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION

Tech is located in the Tech Barn across the driveway from the Scoring Tower.

Event wristband and pre-entry or at-track entry receipt is required to enter Technical Inspection.

A CMRA Tech Verification Form must be completed with VIN# and turned in for every machine that is submitted for technical inspection regardless of whether or not any contingency is being claimed.

RADIO FREQUENCIES AND LIVE TIMING

Monitor 106.3 FM for PA announcements.

Monitor 157.6050 MHz on your scanner for Race Control information; it is recommended that each endurance team have one crewmember monitoring this channel at all times during the race.
