

2009 Team Michelin Contingency Program Rules

Contingency Program Qualifications

- Competitors must register and purchase tires from Authorized Team Michelin race tire distributor or associate.
- Competitors must list Michelin as a sponsor.
- Display minimum of two 12" Michelin decals (one each side) on each side of fairing, Michelin Man decal on both sides of the front fender.
 - Supermoto Riders
 - Display minimum of two 8" Michelin decals (one each side) on each front fork tube, Michelin Man decal on both sides of the swingarm.
- Riders must display a minimum of one Michelin patch on riding gear.
- **Must run Michelin on front and rear tire to be eligible for Team Michelin contingency.**
- Complete claim form on day of race and have verified by race official.
- Minimum Rider Count - Must start each class for contingency to be paid.
 - Road Racing
 - Each class must start a minimum of 10 riders for contingency dollars to be paid 1st- 5th, 6 riders to pay 1st -3th.
 - Minimum 6 riders in class for contingency to be earned.
 - CMRA Racing - Endurance
 - Each endurance class must start a minimum of 8 teams for contingency dollars to be paid 1st - 4th, 6 teams to pay 1st - 3rd.
 - Minimum 6 teams in class for contingency to be earned.
 - 1st - 3rd overall paid every event

- Competitors will be issued an XTRM Pro Bonus Awards Visa Debit card from XTRM. This card will be updated electronically after each win regardless of series. The XTRM Pro Bonus Awards Visa Debit card from XTRM can be used at any ATM or merchant that accepts VISA.
- Competitors have 90 days from the date of the race to inquire about missing payments.
- Claims received more than 90 days after the race will not be processed.
- Contingency will be paid via XTRM.com to the AMA Pro Bonus Awards Visa Debit card.
