### **Who is the CMRA?**

The CMRA is a non-profit organization that provides members with an opportunity to support and participate in closed-course motorcycle road racing. For 36 years, the CMRA has provided its members an avenue to test man (or woman) and machine in a controlled environment. One of America's premier amateur road racing organizations, we hold many events annually in the South Central U.S.

Our history includes world class racers such as Freddie Spencer, Kevin Schwantz, Doug Polen, Britt Turkington, Jamie James and John Kocinski. Current and past champions Colin Edwards, Nicky Hayden, Tommy Hayden, Roger Hayden, Ben Spies, Ricky Parker and Danny Eslick made their road racing start with the CMRA.

### **What are the benefits of Associate Membership?**

For those who do not want to race, but still want to be an active part of the CMRA, we offer an Associate Membership. Benefits include access to the members-only Message Board on the CMRA website, voting rights, and discounts at participating motorcycle shops.

### **How can you get on the track?**

To get started, you must complete the CMRA License School. Our schools are held on the Friday before every event and other dates throughout the season. The school will teach you the 'rules of the road' for the track and provide pointers on bike preparation. At all race events other than those held at Hallett Motor Racing Circuit, the CMRA New Rider School is taught by Lone Star Track Days. Please consult their website ([www.lstd.com](http://www.lstd.com)) for available dates. License Schools held at Hallett are taught by the CMRA and no preregistration is required.

After you have completed the License School and applied for your Associate Membership, you may practice at any open track day at Oak Hill Raceway. Note: You must have full racing gear and a race-prepped bike to practice.

### **How else can you be involved?**

For the closest non-racing seat in the house, corner working provides action, weekend gate pass, lunch and \$\$\$ in your pocket.
