Fill out all spaces on both the **Application** AND the **2012 Annual Emergency Contact Form** completely. **PRINT NEATLY – ILLEGIBLE FORMS WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.** New applicants must attach a copy of your Driver's License, birth certificate or other proof of age. If the Applicant is under the age of 18, attach the notarized CMRA Minor Release Form. **Mail the forms with a check or money order or FAX the forms with credit card information to the address on the bottom of the Application.** Forms sent as email attachments WILL NOT BE PROCESSED.

For 37 years, the CMRA has provided its members an avenue to test man (or woman) and machine in a controlled environment. One of America's premier amateur road racing organizations, we hold many events annually in the South Central U.S.

Our history includes world class racers such as Freddie Spencer, Kevin Schwantz, Doug Polen, Britt Turkington, Jamie James and John Kocinski. Current and past champions Colin Edwards, Nicky Hayden, Tommy Hayden, Roger Hayden, Ben Spies, Ricky Parker and Danny Eslick made their road racing start with the CMRA.

What are the benefits of Associate Membership?

For those who do not want to race, but still want to be an active part of the CMRA, we offer an Associate Membership. Benefits include access to the Message Board on the CMRA website, voting rights, and discounts at participating motorcycle shops.

How can you get on the track?

To get started, you must complete the CMRA License School. Our schools are held on the Friday before every event and other dates throughout the season. The school will teach you the 'rules of the road' for the track and provide pointers on bike preparation. At all race events other than those held at Mercedes-Benz of Sugar Land Road Course (MBSRC) and Hallett Motor Racing Circuit (HMRC), the CMRA Licensing School is taught by Lone Star Track Days. Please consult their website (www.lstd.com) for available dates. Licensing Schools held on the Friday of our race weekends at MBSRC and HMRC are taught by the CMRA and no preregistration is required. Contact the CMRA office for additional information. Please Note: Membership fees paid by Associate Members wishing to upgrade during the year will be credited toward racer licensing fees.

How else can you be involved?

For the closest non-racing seat in the house, corner working provides action, weekend gate pass, lunch and \$\$\$ in your pocket.
