A Riders Briefing will be held each morning: Friday at 7:20am and 12:15pm, Saturday and Sunday at 7:15am.

All riders participating in each days practice and or races are required to attend.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION

Technical Inspection will be open on Thursday July 23th from 7:30 – 9:00pm for pre-entered riders only. Pre-entry packets will be available for pick up in the tech area starting at 7:15pm

Tech is located in the garage at the far end of the paddock next to pit out. Event wristband and pre-entry or at-track entry receipt is required to enter Technical Inspection.

A CMRA Tech Verification Form must be completed with VIN# and turned in for every machine that is submitted for technical inspection regardless of whether or not any contingency is being claimed.
